First settled around 1820, Magee began with the arrival of brothers-in-law Arthur Mangum and Phillip Magee, who moved with their families from North Carolina. They purchased land for 12 1/2 cents an acre and were soon joined by more pioneers from the Carolinas and Virginia.

In 1840, Willis Magee, son of Phillip, built a gristmill on Little Goodwater Creek inside the present city limits. In 1855, Magee established the area's first post office. The community grew steadily and was incorporated as a village on February 25, 1900. By 1910 the village had a population of 685 and was an active trade center.

Today, Magee is a thriving city of nearly 5,000 that boasts a diverse mix of businesses and services that form the bedrock for the economic, social, and civic strengths of our community. Magee steadfastly approaches the future with a progressive attitude while being mindful of preserving the friendly hometown atmosphere we all hold dear. The best of both worlds, Magee is a great place to live and work. We are delighted you have decided to become a part of us.

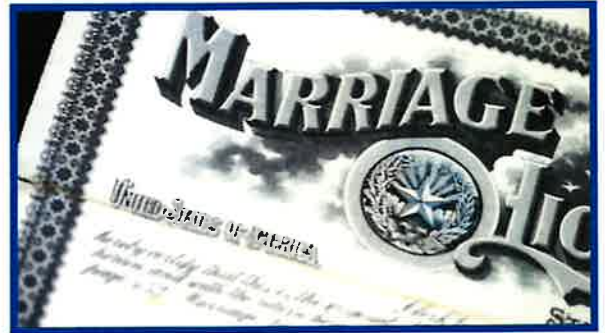

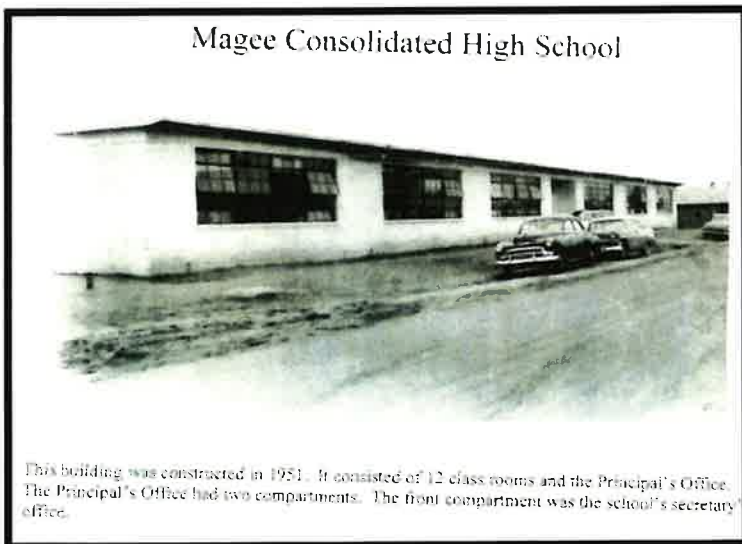
